

The 6th Annual Bushido Dojo     Black Belt Kata Competition

THE KATA (in order of performance):

1) Kuhanku 2) Naihanchi 3) Chinto 4) Seishan 5) Wanshu 6) Bassai 7) Niseishi 8) Jion 9) Jitte 10) Rohai

THE RULES:

1. All competitors will report to the ring at the beginning of each round to be chosen for the order of competition for that round by luck of the draw (to assure random order of each round).
2. Each competitor will individually perform the kata of that round and be scored. The judges' scores will not be shown or called out, but written and handed to the score keeper.
3. The panel of 5 or more judges will score the kata with the low and high score being dropped, and the remaining scores will be added up to determine 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place, and 4th place for that round.
4. At the end of each round, 4th place thru 1st place will be determined.
5. Each competitor will receive the following points as they placed in each round:
 - 1st Place will receive 100 points
 - 2nd Place will receive 90 points
 - 3rd Place will receive 80 points
 - 4th Place will receive 70 points
6. Others successfully performing the kata will receive 60 points
7. If there is a tie for any place in any round, the tie will stand and each competitor will receive the points. This will assure that the competition will proceed in a timely manner without repeating a round.
8. At the end of all 10 rounds, the points of each competitor will be totaled to determine 1st or Grand Champion
9. Then the remaining highest scoring overall competitors will receive a Championship Trophy in the following categories: Male / Female / Senior – TBD based upon ages
10. If there is a tie for 1st Place at the end of all 10 katas, there will be a run-off. For the tie breaker, any kata can be demonstrated, from either the previous list of 10 Wado kata performed.
